OSHA REGULATORY & COMPLIANCE UPDATES:

- **Hazard Communication (HazCom / GHS deadline: May 19, 2026)** — Employers must finalize updated chemical labels, Safety Data Sheets, and employee training to meet the latest GHS-aligned requirements.
- **Heat Safety enforcement is ramping up** — OSHA is increasing inspections and citations related to heat illness prevention, especially in outdoor and high-heat indoor industries.
- **Fall protection emphasis (May Safety Stand-Down)** — Construction sites are seeing heightened attention on fall hazards with

heightened attention on fall hazards, with renewed focus on ladders, scaffolding, and roofing safety compliance.

- **Recordkeeping & reporting tightening** — OSHA is intensifying enforcement around injury logs and electronic reporting accuracy, making documentation errors a growing risk.
- **Silica enforcement remains aggressive** — Inspections continue to target respirable silica exposure controls, including air monitoring, PPE use, and written exposure plans.
- **Whistleblower protection enforcement increasing** — OSHA is placing greater focus on retaliation claims tied to safety reporting and employee complaints.
- **Compliance assistance initiatives expanding** — OSHA is pairing stronger enforcement with more educational programs aimed at improving proactive workplace safety systems.

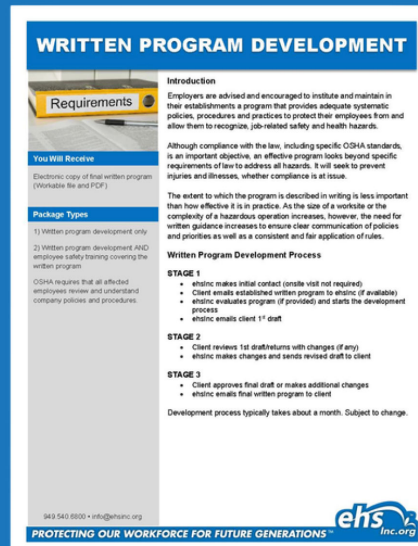
