01 OSHA REGULATORY & COMPLIANCE UPDATES

– HEAT SEASON

Heat enforcement is ramping up. OSHA is increasing inspections and citations for heat illness prevention — especially outdoor and high-heat indoor industries.

– CONSTRUCTION

Fall protection emphasis. Following the May Safety Stand-Down, sites are seeing heightened focus on ladders, scaffolding, and roofing safety.

– DOCUMENTATION

Recordkeeping & reporting tightening. Enforcement around injury logs and electronic reporting accuracy is intensifying — documentation errors are a growing risk.

– EXPOSURE CONTROLS

Silica enforcement remains aggressive. Inspections target respirable silica controls: air monitoring, PPE use, and written exposure plans.
